Based off of feedback from the fall state steamfitter committee meeting, the requirements for supervision of service/refrigeration steamfitter apprentices did not reflect industry standard in WI. BAS formed a work group to create a service card program and outline the process for the state committee to review. Committee reviewed this proposal. BAS also provided an alternative with proposed supervision language revisions to address the committee's concerns in lieu of a Service Card requirement/.

Proposed language addition to the Standards Supervision section:

Supervision of Apprentices:

C. Apprentices in Steamfitter (Service/Refrigeration) who have completed one year of training as an apprentice, completed a minimum of 100 hours of paid related instruction, and completed a specified unpaid related instruction program (90 hours) in service/repair may work under indirect supervision on jobs for which they are trained and qualified. The apprentice must have immediate access to a journeyworker or qualified individual via phone, radio, or other electronic means.

BAS advised that If committees want to recognize prior experience and schooling they should grant apprentices advanced standing as allowed per the WI Apprenticeship Manual. It was noted that someone with prior HVAC experience or an AA degree when signing their contract should receive advanced standing for that.

b. **Minimum requirements for apprentices:** There was a discussion on a local committee's plan to engage with GAN to create updated selection processes.

BAS advised that this would be a local decision to adopt this process and it would need to be included in Standards and Selection Procedures. The use of GAN would not be included in state standards.
