IV: Use Data to Advance Health Equity

The organization has performance improvement systems and infrastructure that provide actionable data for improvement and accountability advancing health equity

IV: Use Data to Advance Health Equity

- Develop and maintain data systems – including data collection and analysis - with an expanded understanding of structural and intermediary determinants
- Analyze data effectively in order to monitor trends and impacts of social determinants of health and health inequities
- Report data to stakeholders and the public in order to promote action to advance health equity

Summary

“The predominant understanding of health inequities continues to focus on receipt of health care services and the behavioral choices of individuals”

Description of Inequity (Problem)

“Develop and maintain data systems – including data collection and analysis - with an expanded understanding of structural and intermediary determinants”

Recommendation

“Using data to advance health equity requires bringing together multiple sources of data, including data on health outcomes as well as data that focuses on intermediary and structural determinants of health, which influence social and economic conditions”
