5-BS-280 - Joint Application of Wisconsin Electric Power Company, Wisconsin Public Service Corporation, and Madison Gas and Electric Company for Approval to Acquire Ownership Interests in the Saratoga Solar Electric Generation and Battery Energy Storage System Facility in the Town of Saratoga, Wood County, Wisconsin and the Ursa Solar Electric Generation Facility in the Towns of Courtland and Springvale, Columbia County, Wisconsin

The Commission approved the Notice of Investigation and directed that it be signed by the Secretary to the Commission.

6680-TE-112 - Application of Wisconsin Power and Light Company for Approval to Modify its Arrears Management Program Tariff

The Commission approved Wisconsin Power and Light Company's (applicant) request to modify its Arrears Management Program. The applicant shall work with Commission staff to develop performance metrics and reporting requirements and shall report on the agreed metrics on an annual basis.

The Commission directed the Division of Energy Regulation and Analysis to draft an order consistent with its discussion.
