Main Types of Medicaid Data

Claims and Encounter Data

- ▶ Services rendered
- ▶ Billing and rendering provider information
- ▶ Drug utilization and costs
- ▶ Payments to providers

Eligibility and Enrollment Data

- ▶ Income
- ▶ Household composition
- ▶ Member demographic data

Other Data Sources

- ▶ Division of Public Health Vital Statistics
- ▶ Homeless Management Information System
- ▶ Consumer Assessment of Health Care Providers and Systems (CAHPS) survey

How We Leverage Data to Effect Change

- ▶ Routine monitoring via executive dashboards
- ▶ Formal evaluations
