Adding FTE or personnel for the trauma program

Staff education or courses

Performance improvement and patient safety

Best practice care or process guidelines

General opportunities:

- Evaluate FTE of the TPM, TMD, and Trauma Registrar
- Consider leveraging your system
- Consider leveraging other ED or quality staff
- Conduct a financial analysis of your trauma program

Adding FTE or personnel for the trauma program

General opportunities:

- Consider education or courses for TPM, TMD, and Trauma Registrar
- Consider trauma-specific education provided to ED staff
- If you admit any injured patients, consider trauma-specific education for inpatient staff
- Consider monetary support from RTACs

Staff education or courses

General recommendations:

- Improving documentation of levels of review, action plans, and loop closure
- More robust audit filters
- Further develop PIPS plan
- Include trauma registry data into PIPS activities
- Education or courses related to PIPS

Performance improvement and patient safety

General recommendations:

- Consider utilization of the registry PI section for reviews
- Utilize data from the registry to drive PI activities
- Revise data validation plan

Trauma registry data entry and performance improvement

General recommendations:

- Revise guidelines to encompass national guidelines
- Further develop admission or transfer guidelines
- Inpatient care guidelines
