3. Pediatric dashboard review (*Informational/Discussion*)
 - Why are some “other” categories so high? Is there a specific region these are high in?
 - What is in the “other accidental e-code of injury” category? Can we break this down into a “sporting” category?
 - Request to breakdown by age group general vehicle and off-road vehicle accidents
 - Look into “undetermined cause of injury” on the injury mortality rate slide
 - Consider looking into mortality outside of a pediatric trauma center vs at a pediatric trauma center
 - With the above possible changes, would like STAC to vote on in December
4. Pediatric Imaging Guideline Data Metrics Presentation by American Family Children’s Hospital, Children’s Wisconsin, and Marshfield Medical Center (*Informational/Discussion*)

One year ago the State Pediatric Imaging Guidelines were released from the three pediatric trauma centers. Each center presented their data from 2021-2023 to see if the guidelines had an impact. There was some change but still a ways to go. Will continue to monitor. A question from a facility if they can get their specific hospital information and each center said you can reach out to them for further discussion.
