September 21, 2021 Self-Insurers Council Meeting Minutes Via teleconference

## 1. Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 9:35 a.m. in conformance with Wisconsin's open meeting law.

## 2. Review and approval of the minutes of previous meeting

Minutes of April 13, 2021 regular meeting were reviewed and approved as written.

## 3. Open session

New council member, Ms. Eitland, was introduced. Ms. Eitland is employed with Kwik Trip.

Mr. Peters represented DWD to thank and conveyed the department's appreciation for Ms. McKinzie's outstanding services during her tenure with the Council. Staff and Council members thanked Ms. McKinzie for her remarkable services and congratulated her on her retirement. Ms. McKinzie had been a council member since 07/01/2006 and her official last day was June 30, 2021.

Mr. Moreth thanked council members for their continuous support, gave an overview of Council members' responsibilities, and reminded members about maintaining financial information confidentiality for program participants.

Ms. Yeap gave a quick overview of current operational status of a former self-insured employer, Verso, which closed its Wisconsin Rapids mill at the end of July. Atlas Holdings has made an offer to buy Verso Corp., which includes its Wisconsin Rapids mill.
