Trauma Registry Updates

- Importing facilities: Use trauma import form beginning in 2024
- Hospital administrator accounts
 - ◆ 1-2 per site
 - ◆ Permission group is used for hospital data reports
 - ◆ Hospital administrators help keep users up to date
 - ◆ Do not delete accounts but inactivate users
 - ◆ DHS will do annual review of user accounts

Trauma Registry Updates

- Incident forms in Patient Registry
 - ◆ Core: Contains all required state and NTDB data elements and a few optional elements for incidents that meet inclusion criteria.
 - ◆ Comprehensive: Contains all required state and NTDB data elements and more optional elements for incidents that meet inclusion criteria.
 - ◆ Activation only: Does not contain all required state and NDTB data elements. Intended for patients that had TTA but do not meet criteria.
 - ◆ Trauma import (active in 2024): Importing facilities only for all incidents.

Trauma Registry Updates

- Form Examples

- ◆ Patient had a TTA, was discharged home from ED, and no qualifying injury
 - Activation only form
- ◆ Patient had a TTA, was discharged home from ED, and had qualifying injury
 - Core or comprehensive form

Trauma Registry Updates

- TR33.1 Referring Hospital
 - ◆ Definition: the name of the facility that cared for the patient immediately before the patient arrived at your facility
 - ◆ Referring hospital cannot be the same as your hospital, even if the patient is transferred from your hospital to another.

Trauma Registry Updates

- Patient Registry discussion for all levels
 - ◆ Features that would be nice to have
 - ◆ Features that must be available
 - ◆ Customizations
 - ◆ Legacy data
 - ◆ Benefit of using one vendor per system
 - ◆ Benefit of using one vendor for customer service and troubleshooting
 - ◆ Decision timeline

2024 Data Dictionary

- New style

- Addition of optional elements
- Updates will occur annually
 - ◆ If additional data element is needed during non-voting timeframe, facility defined questions can be utilized.
 - ◆ Remember to bring them up prior to next voting timeframe to be considered for the next data dictionary.
