Focus group members presented the subsequent revisions and their benefits. The committee agreed that the revisions better address the varying priorities between utilities.

**Action:** the state committee approved the final draft, effective for all new contracts as of November 1, 2022.

#### 5. Discussions

#### a. BAS Directors Call with State Committees

Mr. Smith reviewed that the Directors' Call provides a single, virtual forum for the Bureau to report apprenticeship updates to all state committees.
