

Trauma Registry Data



E-bike Injuries in the Trauma Registry




Injuries in the trauma registry with a cause of injury ICD-10 code related to E-bikes such as V23.01 or V29.001


Pedal Cycle Injuries (V10-V19) in the Trauma Registry




E-scooter and Other Micromobility Device Injuries (V00.84) in the Trauma Registry




Comparison of Pedal Cycle and E-bike Codes in the Trauma Registry




Pedal Cycle Injury ISS, 2024



eBike Injury ISS, 2024




EMS Responses to E-bike Injuries





EMS Responses to E-scooter Injuries in 2025, Ages 55 and Under










ATV, UTV, or Other Offroad Vehicle Crash by AODA, 2024






Pediatric Falls by Age in 2024




Falls by Category in 2024 – Ages 0-4
