**Wisconsin Coastal Management Council Meeting
Thursday, February 20**

The Wisconsin Coastal Management Council will meet on Thursday, February 20, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at Port Milwaukee, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

The Council will receive a welcome from Jackie Carter, Port Director. The Council will take action on the report of the Project Selection Committee, which summarizes the Committee's recommendations for Coastal Management Grant applications. The Council will also take action on a Program Change Submission, which includes proposed revisions to the program's enforceable policies and Program Document.

The Council will hear reports from Michael Timm, Reflo, Zachary Kron, Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, Tia Torhorst, Harbor District, Inc., and Kristin Schultheis, Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District.

The Council provides policy direction for the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program. The Governor appoints members of the Council to represent state agencies, local governments, tribal governments, and the general public.

The Wisconsin Coastal Management Program is dedicated to preserving and improving Wisconsin's Great Lakes resources. The program awards federal funds from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Office for Coastal Management and U.S. Department of Commerce, to local, state, and tribal governments, universities and non-profit organizations, for innovative coastal initiatives. The Coastal Management Grant Program supports projects focusing on wetland protection, habitat restoration, nonpoint pollution control, land use planning, Great Lakes education, public access, historic preservation, and land acquisition.
