County Supplemental Awards (set asides included) <i>Funding can be utilized to meet the COVID related BH needs in each County.</i>
Tribal Supplemental Awards (set asides included) <i>Funding can be utilized to meet the COVID related BH needs in each Tribe</i>
Early Serious Mental Illness <i>Expand Coordinated Specialty Care in WI to other sites and offer training on model to fidelity</i>
Crisis Services-County/Non-Profit <i>Expand and enhance crisis system in to move towards SAMSHA best practices</i>
Workforce Development <i>Expansion of EBP in WI through support of training and technical assistance in crisis, SUD, dialectical behavioral therapy and other services + expansion of Qualified Treatment Trainee (QTT) program</i>
State Operations <i>Staffing support for administration of the supplemental funding</i>
Harm Reduction Ex = Narcan expansion in Jail facilities, Naloxboxes and EMS leave behind programs <i>Expansion of harm reduction strategies and distribution of Narcan with emergency services, in jails, etc. to connect to the most vulnerable population</i>
Prevention Activities (Including tobacco) <i>Set aside requirement to support tobacco prevention, youth substance use and expansion of regional crisis centers focused on support of communities and coalitions primary substance use prevention work</i>
Women's Treatment <i>Set aside requirement and expansion of existing women's and family treatment residential settings and care coordination</i>
Recovery Support/Peer Support Expansion <i>Additional Peer Run Respite and Peer Run Centers, Peer Specialists, Recovery Coaches, and peer to peer connection and support in BH</i>
Data Dashboards/Data Development Initiatives <i>Improve and enhance data systems to monitor outcomes related to opioid epidemic initiatives. Could also include evaluation on use of telehealth and outcomes</i>
Warm Lines – including Hmong peer support <i>Infrastructure support and development of warm line supports for peers, focus on underserved population support as well</i>
Telehealth Expansion for MAT <i>Infrastructure development for telehealth use for MAT into rural communities</i>
Children's System of Care Development <i>Continued support of promotion of Wraparound as evidenced based practice to support youth with SED</i>
