- 1. Welcome and committee member check-in. Meeting called to order at 1:09pm.
- 2. Roll Call of committee members.
- 3. Motion to approve PAC minutes from June 2019 meeting made by Dr. Schultz, second by Dr. Kronenfeld. Motion passes.
- 4. State Medical Director's Report provided by Dr. Colella.
- 5. State EMS Office report provided by Mark Lockhart.
- 6. Discussion to review and prioritize initiatives contained within the State EMS Plan: 2020-2022.
- 7. Discussion of final draft of Interfacility Transport Guidelines with motion to recommend adoption to EMS Board. Motion by Dr. Clark, second by Dr. Schultz to recommend adoption; all in favor, motion carries. \*\*\* At October 15, 2019 meeting, it was brought up that this was not on the agenda for the September 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting and therefor the vote was taken in error. Please see minutes from October 15, 2019 meeting regarding decision on this topic.\*\*\*
- 8. Public comment from Jared Thompson (Wausau Fire EMS Chief) regarding prehospital ultrasound. Jared completed the Scope of Practice Change Request Worksheet and presented request to PAC.
- 9. Discussion, review, and possible action on EMR scope of practice. Goal is to align Wisconsin's EMR scope with national scope, as well as to provide life-saving, time critical intervention and treatment.
  - a. Proposal to add nebulized albuterol to the EMR scope as an optional skill. Albuterol will remain in EMR scope for both metered dose inhaler, or nebulizer. Motion by Dr. Eberlein, second by Dr. Clark. Motion passed.
  - b. Going forward, items in national scope will be required in Wisconsin scope, and items that exceed national scope may be optional or required. Wisconsin curriculum should follow this directive. Dr. Kronenfeld made this motion, second by Dr. Marquis. Motion passed.
  - c. Motion by Dr. Zils to remove all non-visualized airways from the EMR scope. Second by Dr. Kronenfeld. Motion passed with Dr. Marquis opposed.
