David Polk explained the training video was created so committee members can get training on how they should handle harassment and discrimination complaints from apprentices. Jamie Bernthal with WTCS also informed the committee that she is conducting a follow up survey for apprentices who took part in a grant offered through WCTS. She wants to see what type of impact the grant had on apprentices. She asked that all apprentices who participate, contact him directly with their comments.

Liz Pusch said at the next committee meeting, BAS can provide that report.
